Illness Update

Thank you for your co-operation over the past week with regards to sickness absence. Whilst we still have a number of children and staff ill with flu or the winter vomiting bug, the numbers have begun to decrease over the course of the week.

Public Health England's advice about staying away from school in case of illness and for 48 hours after the last bout of Diarrhoea or Vomiting also applies for upcoming Christmas events unfortunately. If you are ill with the winter vomiting bug at the time of the event or are not 48 hours clear of symptoms of the winter vomiting bug at the time of the event (e.g, Christmas Fair) then we do ask for Public Health's guidance to be followed and for you not to attend the event in order to limit the spread of the bug.
