## Concrete

You will no doubt have seen a lot in the news about RAAC (Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete) and its use in schools. The concrete is a cheap, lightweight alternative to traditional concrete which was used in construction (not just in schools) between 1950's and 1990's. As Mowbray was built in the 1920's with various additions over the years, a check of the buildings has taken place and initial structural surveyor surveys indicate that we do not have any of the concrete at Mowbray. This will be confirmed with an in depth survey following guidance from the Department for Education as is being widely reported on the news.
