Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back to school. I hope everyone had an enjoyable Christmas break.

After a fantastic first term, the children have all settled quickly back into school and are ready for another busy term.

NUFC Foundation

Our continued work with the NUFC Foundation has provided us with some more match tickets – this time for the Cardiff City game. These were drawn by Mr Davison this week with 2 tickets going to Josh in Willow Class and 2 tickets to Dylan in Maple Class.

In a surprise addition, Mr Davison was contacted on the teacher training day to say that some work he had completed for the Foundation had been of such an exemplary nature that we had been awarded a Mascot package. One child would be a Mascot at the Manchester City game, would lead the players out and meet both teams. The focus had to be attendance or pupils who fulfilled the FA's #befair criteria. This was drawn and Billy from Year 6 is very excited to be the Mascot!

Car Parking

Since we returned to school we have been contacted several times by members of the public complaining about inconsiderate parking which has blocked paths for pushchairs and wheelchairs. Please be considerate of others when parking – it isn't acceptable for pedestrians, pushchairs or wheelchairs to have to walk onto Stakeford Lane to avoid parked cars.

Lateness

The number of people arriving late improved throughout last term but is currently very high again. Please ensure that your children are on time for school. Any children arriving late must be signed into the school office by an adult. We have had a few incidents of older children who walk themselves to and from school arriving late. In cases where unaccompanied children arrive late, parents/carers will be informed.

48 Hour Sickness Absence

In line with other schools in the partnership, we will be trialling a new policy this term in relation to sickness. Currently we ask children who have had vomiting/diahorrea to stay off school for 48 hours after the last episode. Until Easter we will trial a reduction to 24 hours of absence after the last episode rather than the 48 hours. We will monitor the impact of this change until Easter before deciding if it will become a permanent policy alteration.
