Absences

A reminder that if your child is absent from school you must telephone the office to report the absence and the reason for absence as soon as possible. Current government statistics class any attendance rate under 90% as a persistent absentee which may result in a referral to the Education Welfare Services. If your child's attendance falls under 93% you will be contacted by school to inform you of this and to offer any support to help improve your child's attendance.

Vandalism to School

It's unfortunate that I have to inform you that once again we have been targeted over a weekend by thieves attempting to remove metalwork (pipes, lead etc) from the school roof. Again this has resulted in several hundred pounds of damage. If you see any unusual activity over a weekend or holiday at school, please contact the police directly. If you have any information about the current theft please contact myself or the police.

School Dinner Money

Please ensure that dinner money is paid and up to date. The school debt collection policy has been in place since last year and is available via the website. If you have unsettled debt you will be asked to provide a packed lunch or collect your child for lunchtime until the debt is settled. School dinner debt can mount quickly for the school and if not settled, costs school potentially hundreds of pounds which could be otherwise spent on educational resources.

Free School Meals

If you believe your child may be eligible for Free School Meals, please speak to the office. Alternatively, all teachers will have application forms ready to complete during your parents' evening appointments next week. If you are unsure whether you are eligible or not, please complete the form anyway at your appointment and the County Council will check your eligibility.

New Collections Policy

The new policy for collecting children from school was due to be implemented from Monday. Unfortunately, 50 forms have still not been returned yet. This will delay the policy starting until we return after the half term. Parents who still need to return a form have been notified.

When we return after half term, any parents who have still not authorised another adult to collect their children by returning the "Collection Arrangement Form" will only have their children returned to them and no other adult.

School Money

After half term, the online payment system will not require you to prebook your child's meals. You will be able to add the amount of credit you want at any time and this will be reduced each time your child presents themselves at the till. A further letter about this will come out next week.
