Year 6 Summer Term



Physical Education *Self-Belief, Risk, Perseverance*

Our topics in PE this term are: Athletics, netball and striking and fielding.



Writing

Life Skills, Aspiration, Resilience

Writing will be based around themes of books read in class, including both fiction and non-fiction genres:

- Diary
- Informal Letter
- Non-chronological report
- Newspaper report
- Poetry (love and grief)



Science

Curiosity, Risk, Perseverance

Children will study light and electricity. In the light topic the children will investigate the properties of light, how it travels and shadows. In the electricity topic the children will learn to build a working circuit using various components.



History
