STEM Communities

Year 5 and Year 6 are undertaking STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) workshops with Woodhorn Museum. The focus has been computer coding to control a space rover on Mars as well as learning about how these are tested in Whitby before going to Mars! The "Mining and Mars" family sessions from 3.30pm – 4.30pm on Monday 27 January and Monday 3 February have been very popular. Mrs Beattie reports there are a few places left on 3 February but 27 January is now fully booked. Siblings are able to attend these sessions.

New Minibus

You will have noticed a new Mowbray Minibus since we returned to school.

The costs of the bus are fully covered by the County Council as it is supporting the home to school transport for children attending the Specialist Support Base. During the school day, the bus gives us more flexibility with providing school trips for all children without incurring increased travel costs.

Appleby Centre and Parking

We have had a number of complaints since our return regarding parking. The Appleby Centre near the entrance lane from Wansbeck Avenue have complained about Mowbray parents/carers driving at high speeds down the access road to park and drop off at the back of Mowbray. While there is not complaint about the parking, there are complaints about the driver's speed. We've been notified that registration details will be passed to the police if speeding persists. Please consider the safety of all users of that area as many children are dropped off in that zone.

We have also received a number of parking complaints from residents on Woodhorn Drive reporting blocked drives. Please be considerate when parking.
