Mobile Telephones / Smart Phones

A reminder that no children should be bringing mobile phones or smart phones into school. If there is a valid reason for your child to have a phone, this should be sent in in writing to the main office and your child should sign their phone into the office at the start of the day and then sign it out at the end of the day. Using phones on the school site is difficult to monitor and could lead to breaches of our safeguarding or child protection procedures if, for example, photos or videos are taken and then shared. If a child forgets to sign their phone in to the office, a staff member will look after it until the end of the school day when a parent / carer may be contacted to collect it.

School will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to phones that are sent into school.

Collection Details

Please ensure that the office is informed of any changes to adults you are authorising to collect your children. These changes should be given in writing (e.g email). Please make sure any adults collecting your children know your password. If children spend their time between two households, please consider whether more than one Collection List is required (e.g one for each parent). This is not essential but may be helpful in some cases.

It is a safeguarding requirement that we hold at least two up to date contact phone numbers for each child. If you change your details, please update them with the school office straight away.
