Our excellent start to the new academic year has continued and I would like to take the opportunity to thank you all for your support in helping it run smoothly.

Year 1 Larch Class

Over the end of the Summer and the first few weeks of term, several new children joined the school in Year 1. This resulted in a slightly than average class size for Larch. As a result, we have increased Mrs Sullivan to a full time contract and added her permanently to Larch class as a second class teacher. This now means that there are two full time teachers within the class which allows a flexible smaller group approach to teaching. Although the class is larger, the children will be taught in smaller groups of under 20 for all lessons. If you have any questions about this, please contact Miss Ewart or Mrs Sullivan.

Collections Arrangements
