Car Parking

We have received a number of complaints about inconsiderate and illegal parking by parents / carers at pick up and drop off times. These include cars being parked across driveways, on footpaths or blocking crossing points. The result has been that residents have been unable to access their properties and paths have been blocked for those with pushchairs or mobility issues. In some cases, children have had to cross roads between parked cars. Please consider where you park if you need to drive to school. Parking Enforcement Officers do operate outside of schools and inconsiderate or illegal parking could lead to Penalty Notices being issued.

Lateness

Our attendance registers are monitored regularly by the Education Welfare Service. As part of this, lateness to school is also monitored. We understand that occasionally situations may occur that cause your child to be late to school. Currently, lateness is running from only a couple of minutes late to 30-40 minutes late. Please ensure you leave enough time to get into school in a morning. Doors open from 8.30am and close at 8.45am – after this time your child would be recorded as late to school.
