Staffing Updates

Deadlines and Newsletters

As a polite request, we are asking that any deadlines published in relation to events (e.g. tickets or sales etc) be adhered to and information shared in letters be followed. Several events recently have seen large numbers of requests or attempted purchases come after deadlines have passed. In most cases sales and tickets have been open for several weeks and in the case of the Monster's Ball sales for refreshments were open for over 2 weeks. Stock was bought based on the number of sales. Unfortunately, yesterday over 20 additional purchases were attempted on the day – nearly two weeks after the deadline. While we do not wish to disappoint the children, this would easily have happened if staff had not gone out of their way to ensure it didn't. Similarly, the Harvest Assemblies had a number of people attend who had not read the arrangements or who had purchased the free ticket through Eventbrite. In some of these cases a small number of parents/carers have been aggressive and abusive towards staff members which will not be tolerated.

As we have moved to much of our communication being online – including purchases and bookings for events such as Harvest and Parent's Consultations we appreciate some parents/carers may have technological issues in accessing services at times. If this is the case, please contact the school office who will be happy to help in any way possible.

British Legion Poppy Appeal

When we return after half term we will be participating in the Poppy Appeal to support the Royal British Legion. This year, as well as poppies, we have also been provided with keyrings, wristbands and zip ties. All of these will be available daily for a donation. Donations in this case will be in cash and not through School Money.

Additional Covid-19 Measures

In the last ½ an hour Northumberland Schools have received notification from the County Council and Northumberland Public Health that we should re-introduce some of our Covid-19 restrictions after half term due to the rising case rates across Northumberland.
