Dear Parents/Carers

It was lovely to see so many parents/carers in school last week for the harvest performances. It was great for the children to have an audience to perform to in school again after the past few years of disruption. Monster's Ball

As you are aware, the Monster's Ball is this Thursday during the afternoon for EYFS, Key Stage 1, Holly and Larch classes. Year 5 and Year 6 will have their Ball after school until 4.30pm. We are postponing swimming lessons this week for Year 4 and Year 6 so that they can take part in the Monster's Ball. If children wish to go to the Ball in fancy dress then they are more than welcome to. Fancy dress should be brought in on the day for the children to change into. You should already have received a letter last week from the PTA regarding refreshments for the Monster's Ball – no money should be sent in on the day.

Collections after the Mulberry / Maple / Willow Ball ends at 4.30pm should be from the main entrance.

We apologise if there has been any confusion over whether children attend in fancy dress for the whole day. This did happen last year to fit in with Covid protocols at the time.

Lost Property

We have a rising number of coats / jumpers in lost property. If your child has lost an item of clothing please ask them to check lost property. All items currently in lost property are un-named. House Captains check lost property regularly and return named items – please try to ensure jackets, jumpers etc are named so that they can be returned if they are misplaced.

Attendance

Our attendance is monitored by the Education Welfare Service on a regular basis. During Covid-19 there was flexibility given by the Department for Education around attendance given the legislation that was in place at the time. However, this flexibility has now been withdrawn; the Education Welfare Service will be picking up on poor attendance going forward which could lead to penalty notice fines if your child's attendance is persistently low.
